1. Expand collaboration and data sharing
 - Central MODIS source for products usability
 - Consolidation – coordination
 - ◆ DSS-portals, existing portals – used and not recreated
 - Generic data availability to feed specific projects
 - ◆ DSS portal – accessibility – functionality – usability
 - Data preservation program so we can recreate products
 - Output synergy – other for a for interrelation product output repository

2. How to do a better job working with end user
 - How much can we put on the scientist to transition to user operation
 - End users don't have the capability to pick it up
 - Success stories : No fluff – take the PR out
 - GOMA site with the project locations and end users

3. Areas of interest for future solicitations (focus and increased productivity/end results)
 - Packaging Grants – integrating projects into a more comprehensive program

4. Logistics of Projects (problems setting up, funding, reporting, etc)
 - 1 year tag up –NASA Sponsored \$ formal format needed (more rigor)
 - NASA pick relevant professional meetings such as AIAA and pay for speakers to speak about ROSES projects
